Delta Conservancy Coordinates Clean Up at Brannan Island State Park

WEST SACRAMENTO – The Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Conservancy is partnering with Brannan Island State Park to coordinate a Coastal Clean Up Day at the park on Saturday, September 15th from 9 AM to 11 AM. **WHAT IS COASTAL CLEANUP DAY?** California Coastal Cleanup Day, an annual beach and inland waterway cleanup, is the state's largest volunteer event. In 2010, over 82,500 volunteers removed more than 1.2 million pounds of trash and recyclables from our beaches, lakes, and waterways. Brannan Island is one of the Delta's most outstanding recreation areas, offering fishing, swimming, boating, windsurfing, picnicking and camping in the midst of a thriving wildlife habitat.

“Coastal Clean Up Days are a great way for individuals and families to make a difference in the Delta, and they help increase awareness of the Delta's fragile ecosystem” says Campbell Ingram, Delta Conservancy Executive Officer.

In this clean-up effort, the Delta Conservancy is partnering with Snodgrass Solutions, the California Coastal Commission and the California State University Sacramento Environment Students Organization.
